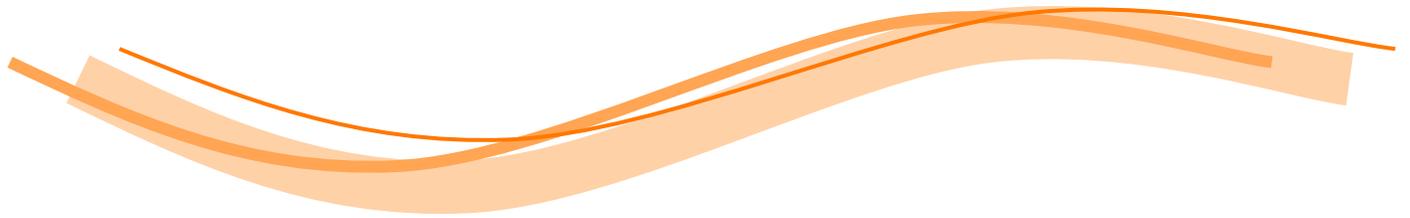

The onboard service is designed to make every flight a great start and end to a wonderful vacation. Grottoes, a treasure house of rare and splendid Chinese sculptures. Located at the southern foot of Wuzhou Mountain, they contain over 50,000 Buddhist statues and stretch for about 1 km east to west. After the visit to the Grottoes, transfer back to the city area, visit the biggest dragon screen in China – Nine Dragon Screen and Huayan Temple.  
Datong Jindi Howard Johnson Hotel (1 night)

**Day 4 Datong – Pingyao (Breakfast & Lunch)**

Travel to Pingyao with a stop at the famous Hanging temple, also known as Hanging Monastery or Xuankong Temple. Built more than 1,500 years ago, this temple is notable not only for its location on a sheer precipice but also because it is the only existing temple with the combination of three Chinese traditional religions: Buddhism, Taoism, and Confucianism. The monastery is located in the small canyon basin, and the body of the building hangs from the middle of the cliff under the prominent summit, protecting the temple from rain erosion and sunlight. Afterwards, visit the Wooden Pagoda at Yingxian County near Hanging Temple. Continue to Pingyao.

Pingyao Yunjincheng Folk Hotel (2 nights)

**Day 5 Pingyao (Breakfast & Lunch)**

Enjoy a tour of the ancient town of Pingyao. The ancient streets, yards and cultures have been preserved well. You will visit the city wall and the first bank – Rishengcang during your stay in Pingyao.

**Day 6 Pingyao – Taiyuan (Breakfast & Lunch)**

Travel to Taiyuan. Visit the Chang's family Mansion en route. It covers an area of 1500 rooms and 40 buildings. Its buildings, courtyard, decorations of each houses are so well kept that you can see the living status of the rich families in 16th century. Transfer to Taiyuan, the capital city of Shan'xi Province.

Taiyuan Trader's House (1 night)

**Day 7 Taiyun – Zhengzhou – Kaifeng (Breakfast)**

Travel by high speed train from Taiyuan to Zhengzhou city. After arrival, transfer from Zhengzhou to Kaifeng, the oldest capital of 8 dynasties in China. In the afternoon, visit the Guild Hall of Shanxi.

Discover Kaifeng city with a visit of the Dragon Pavilion Park in the morning. Visit the Iron Pagoda of Youguo Temple, a Buddhist Chinese pagoda built in 1049 during the Song dynasty. The pagoda is so-named not because it is made of iron, but because its colour resembles that of

	<p>iron. It is a brick pagoda tower built on the location of a previous wooden one that had been burnt down by lightning fire in 1044, it is seen as a masterpiece of Song dynasty architecture. After lunch, visit the Jiaoqing Lane and the Millennium City Park.</p> <p>Day 9 Kaifeng – Dengfeng – Luoyang (Breakfast &amp; Lunch)          Depart Kaifeng this morning for a day tour to Dengfeng. Visit the famous Shaolin Temple, a world famous Buddhist temple in China, located at the west foot of Mount Songshan in a dense bamboo forest at the foot of Wuru Peak on Shaoshi Mountain. After lunch transfer to Luoyang and visit the old town.          Luoyang Friendship Hotel (1 night)</p> <p>Day 10 Luoyang – Beijing (Breakfast &amp; Lunch)          Visit the Longmen Grottoes, one of the top three famous grottoes in China. After lunch transfer to the train station for your high-speed train ride back to Beijing.
