A non-smoking policy is in place. Regular rest stops are provided so that you can stretch your legs, and allow passengers a smoke.
Passports	The Chris Robinson Travel Show always advises listeners to carry their passport with them at all times. This ensures against loss or theft in hotels. For added protection, keep a photocopy of your passport in your suitcase. Hotels are sometimes required to hold your passport in order to comply with local regulations.
